**Arome** Very ripe dark fruits well married with the discrete scent of wood giving it depth.

**Taste** On the first impact the wine is marked by ripe black fruit and chocolate; when opening becomes complex and we realize the notes of the stage in wood. The tannins are present, but very soft give a velvety and consistent body to the wine.

**Finish** Final very elegant and persistent.

**Consumption** Immediate or over the next ten years

**Gastronomy** Serve at 18°C with hunting dishes or condimented red meats
