Total sugars 0,5 g/l

**Color** Dark Ruby

**Arome** Very ripe dark fruits well married with the discrete scent of wood giving it depth.

**Taste** On the first impact the wine is marked by ripe black fruit and chocolate; when opening becomes complex and we realize the notes of the stage in wood. The tannins are presente, but very soft give a velvety and consistente body to the wine

**Finish** Final very elegant and persistente

**Consumption** Immediate or cover the next 10 years

**Gastronomy** Serve at 18°C with hunting dishes or condimented red meats
